The Dangers of Wokeness

What does it mean to be woke and how does it square with the Bible? This session will explore these questions and touch on how believers should react and respond to the woke movement and how we can make a positive impact for Jesus in our churches and communities.

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The term "Woke" came from 1938 blues singer, Huddie Ledbetter (Lead Belly) advised blacks "best stay woke, keep their eyes open" referring to racial violence.

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In **1962**, William Melvin Kelley article in the New York Times on beatniks and slang within the Harlem Jazz scene. If you're **Woke** You Dig it.

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2014- took off on social media after Michael Brown was killed in Ferguson Mo. BLM used the word to rally for social activism against <u>racism</u>, injustice, and <u>police</u> brutality.

According to World Magazine, woke now includes **CRT** and **left** wing political ideology.

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Definitions:

Oxford English Dictionary- Alert to racial or social discrimination and **injustice**.

University of Miami: critical consciousness to intersecting systems of **oppression**.

A pop word that describes state of being awakened to the reality that racism is systemic—deeply engrained as an accepted and assumed part of our culture/society.

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Wokeness identifies <u>racism</u> as the fundamental cause of disparities among racial minorities and believe that racism underlies <u>all</u> of Western society which perpetuates <u>unequal</u> distribution of social privileges between whites and people of color. Wokeness generally assumes that those who are white are <u>inherently unable</u> to identify racism. In addition, if you are woke, you will educate others and promote Social <u>Justice</u>.

Wokeness has also now incorporated advocacy for <u>Transgenderism</u> and <u>LGBTQ</u> issues.

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Wokeness is affecting politics, education (CRT), medicine, mental health, entertainment, business, investing, and etc. including the **CHURCH**!

Related Terms:

- <u>CRT</u>-Critical <u>Race</u> Theory
- <u>DEI</u> in businesses, investments, etc.
 Diversity, <u>Equity</u> and Inclusion.
- Intersectionality- the interconnected nature of race, class, and gender and how they overlap and impact discrimination or disadvantage.

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Characteristics of Wokeness

Divides people into two groups-not lost and saved, but <u>oppressed</u> and <u>oppressors</u>. (usually based on <u>skin color</u>).

<u>Impossible</u> for anyone with the skin color of the "oppressed" to be racist themselves and

<u>Impossible</u> for anyone with the skin color of the oppressor not to be racist.

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Characteristics of Wokeness

The fundamental problem with culture, society, human beings, according to wokism/CRT is unequal distribution of wealth and resources because of <u>racism</u>.

Woke's solution is to <u>tear down</u> social structures and institutions (church, home, legal, government, education, finance, etc) and <u>reset</u> society. **Forced** wealth and resource redistribution (Think Robin Hood)

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Characteristics of Wokeness

Change <u>laws</u> and or <u>standards</u> if there are disproportional racial outcomes.

Change drug laws because more of a certain race have been arrested.

Change courses in school when more of a certain skin color have done well or poorly.

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Characteristics of Wokeness

The Goal is Equal <u>outcomes</u>

NOT equal opportunity.

The Goal is **equity**, not equality.

Dangers—removes Freedom of speech—in church, on radio, on YouTube, websites, etc.

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Characteristics of Wokeness

Control by <u>intimidation</u> (demonstrations, threatened lawsuits, deplatforming, canceling)
Don't ask questions, don't push back, Just go along


If intimidation fails to work, perhaps <u>legal</u> assaults

Some <u>churches</u> have jumped on this train and joined the parade.

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Characteristics of Wokeness

Lucas Miles- *Woke Jesus*- Woke
Christianity-also known as "Conscious Christianity" is broad-stroke
terminology describing Christians
who are intentionally conscious of
oppression, racism and injustice.



Biblically there is only <u>One</u> Race. It is the <u>Human</u> Race or <u>Adam's</u> race.

Acts 17:26 From one man He made every nation of men, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and He determined the times set for them and the exact places where they should live.

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How Does Wokeness Square With The Bible?

Table of <u>Nations</u> in Genesis 10 Moses had a Cushite <u>wife</u>

All humans are genetically <u>identical</u>. Differing amounts of melanin in the <u>skin</u>. We're all genetically cousins! Geneticists now say all living humans had <u>one</u> common female ancestor and <u>one</u> common male ancestor. Like the Bible has told us for thousands of years.

But discrimination based on skin color (Racism) **DOES** exist. And has been a part of American culture in many ways. And sometimes the **church**.

And it is sinful!

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How Does Wokeness Square With The Bible?

Many of those wrongs have been and are being addressed.

The Church needs to be sure not to <u>excuse</u> it in the past or in the present, but to call it <u>sin</u>.

Christians should be concerned about <u>injustice</u>. Whether based on skin color, country of origin, income, religious belief, etc.

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How Does Wokeness Square With The Bible?

But Wokeness redefines racism and <u>perverts</u>
Biblical justice and <u>guts</u> the church of the <u>Gospel</u>
of Jesus. The new <u>gospel</u> of wokeness seeks to
bring salvation by tearing down established
institutions and rebuilding society.

Miles- Critical Race Theory is [responsible] for doctrinally **disemboweling** the modern **church** of its views of salvation, sin, and human suffering.

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How Does Wokeness Square With The Bible?

The Bible teaches individual responsibility for <u>sin</u>. We may bear the consequences of our ancestors sins, but we are not held responsible unless we <u>perpetuate</u> them.

Jesus did <u>not</u> work to overthrow Rome (the obvious oppressors.) Instead He called out <u>sin</u> in both the oppressed as well as the oppressors. As did Paul and all the Disciples. And so is the Church to do today.

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How Does Wokeness Square With The Bible?

At times we are all <u>oppressed</u> to various degrees and at times we are all <u>oppressors</u> to various degrees. To say that one group can't understand is to <u>deny</u> the power of God and His Holy Spirit.

Don't get <u>distracted</u>. Keep your eye on the ball which is sharing <u>Jesus</u>!

The enemy's goal is to <u>cancel</u> Jesus.

Jesus will <u>not</u> be canceled! We must do our part to speak for Him.

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

The solution to society's problems is <u>NOT</u>
Conservatism, <u>NOT</u> getting the right <u>politicians</u>
elected, even if they are Christians. The Solution is

<u>Jesus</u>—the Gospel!

Transformation from the <u>inside</u> out. Of people, of the church, of society, of America.

Instead of joining the Woke movement and "burning it all down" the Bible tells us:

Romans 12:18 If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at <u>peace</u> with everyone.

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

Franklin Graham to the National Religious
Broadcasters: "...if one doesn't talk about sin or
preach the gospel, then that person doesn't
have anything to worry about in society, but if
you're going to try to proclaim the Gospel,
they're going to try to shut you up."

Speak <u>truth</u> when given the opportunity, but do so in <u>love</u>.

<u>The Truth</u> is durable. Teach/preach/do <u>truth</u>
Real <u>love</u> is durable. Teach/preach/do <u>love</u>

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

Be <u>prepared</u> to give a reason for the hope that is in you.

Standing against the tsunami of wokeness takes courage

Don't look for conflict, but don't <u>run</u> from it.

We must <u>support</u> each other—Christians must hang <u>together</u> or we will all hang separately.

(Benjamin Franklin)

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

Do **proactive** ministry! Show <u>love</u> to those of <u>all</u> skin colors, to the poor, single moms, the homeless, LGBT, children, etc

Do so much **good** work in your community that they value you. Not JUST speaking out on LGBT issues.

(YMCA in LA)

Many people are getting tired of being intimidated and having WOKE ideology shoved down their throats.

Some signs people are pushing back: Hershey, Bud Lite, Target, etc,

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

Some Other Concrete Actions:

- Run/support Christian schools
- Help <u>homeschool</u> parents
- Weekday Religious Education
- Teach <u>apologetics</u> in SS classes—not just Scripture, but Scripture applied. Responding to the times.
- Serve teachers **lunch** on a workday. Free ice cream, etc

Remember the Promises of God for His true church---the gates of Hell will **not** prevail against her!

Mark 13:32-37 "But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. Be on guard, **keep awake**. For you do not know when the time will come. It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his servants in charge, each with his work, and commands the doorkeeper to stay awake. **Therefore stay awake**—for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or when the cock crows, or in the morning—lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. And what I

say to you I say to all: Stay awake.'

The ultimate intersection is Jesus' Cross.

It is the place where:

- God's grace intersected with our sin.
- His perfect holiness intersected with His great love.
- All stand before Him equally guilty, but with equal opportunity to be forgiven, cleansed, justified and saved!
- We are all called to intersect with each other.
- The perfect holy eternal God met sinful fallen man.

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How Should We Then Live? How Should We Respond or React?

The ground is level at the foot of the cross.

- For whites and blacks.
- For oppressed and oppressor.
- For young and old.
- For rich and poor.



Jesus died for all. We are all incurably sinful and we all need forgiveness only available through Jesus at His cross. The cross is the intersection where the perfect holy eternal God met sinful fallen man.
