Weekly, my two-and-a-half-year-old grandson, Jericho, and I make our "milk run." The local Christian-run dairy sells milk in glass returnable bottles. They have a hand sink wash up and sanitizer available for little hands after being with the calves. Jericho goes from calf to calf. Pap's handkerchief came to a quick rescue (Note to self – don't blow nose until a clean handkerchief is acquired!) and then to the sink for a face scrub and sanitizer. Jericho then told me clearly that he was "all done" in the calf barn! Let's go look at the tractors!

Approaching Easter is a good time for reflection. What sin is in our lives that has let the "God-image" in which we were created become stained with the "poop" of the world?



Do we come before the Lord in worship with dirty hands and face?
