But He does teach us that He is with us and cares about us, even in the dangerous days that our Congolese Church is experiencing now. There are times of suffering. Such as when Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, there God sent an Angel to strengthen Him. (our Church where the conference was held is named Gethsemane). Also, when the disciples grieved at the death of Jesus on the cross, after which He rose from the dead. So, we pray for an Angel to strengthen our people, and we pray for safety. We place our faith in God. knowing that He cares about our people, and He has a purpose for His Church.
